## London 2012 Ticketshare Scheme

Dear All,

We are delighted to be writing to you in connection with the London 2012 Ticketshare Scheme and the opportunity that the British Paralympic Association (BPA) in conjunction with us, the NGB, will be offering to individuals to attend a Paralympic Games event.

### What is London 2012 Ticketshare?

You can read all about London 2012 Ticketshare at <http://www.london2012.com/visiting/tickets/ticketshare>. In a nutshell, the Ticketshare scheme allows people to attend the Games for no charge. These tickets are funded through a levy on London 2012 Prestige Ticketing hospitality packages.

### Who is the BPA's element of London 2012 Ticketshare going to benefit?

- London 2012 Ticketshare tickets are to be used to help engage and enthuse young disabled people and those involved in the provision and delivery of disability sport, with the aim of inspiring more people to get in to sport. - There are no age restrictions, although tickets are primarily aimed at young disabled people.
- Where necessary tickets will be allocated as a pair to ensure that the care requirements of young disabled people are to be met.
- Those involved in the provision and delivery of disability sport will also be eligible for BPA London 2012 Ticketshare tickets. If these individuals are over 18 years of age and do not have any care requirements only 1 ticket will be allocated.
- Wheelchair and Accessible seats can be requested however LOCOG have stressed that these cannot be guaranteed. Wheelchair tickets include a companion seat.

### Criteria

- You must be a current member of The ASA, Swim Wales or Scottish Swimming.
- You must be a swimmer (or parent/guardian/personal care attendant of), coach or volunteer involved with Disability Swimming.

#### **What is the process in obtaining a BPA London 2012 Ticketshare ticket?**

- A nomination form (as attached) must be completed for all individuals who wish to nominate themselves or someone else and returned to British Disability Swimming Office via email at [wcpdisabilityswimming@swimming.org](mailto:wcpdisabilityswimming@swimming.org) by **Monday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2011**.
- It is likely that there will not be sufficient tickets available to meet all nominations.
- The final decision on the successful nominees rests with us, the NGB, who will carry out a draw following receipt of all nominations on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2011.
- The successful nominees will be announced in early 2012 and tickets distributed soon thereafter to the winners.
